

### Course Pre-requisites

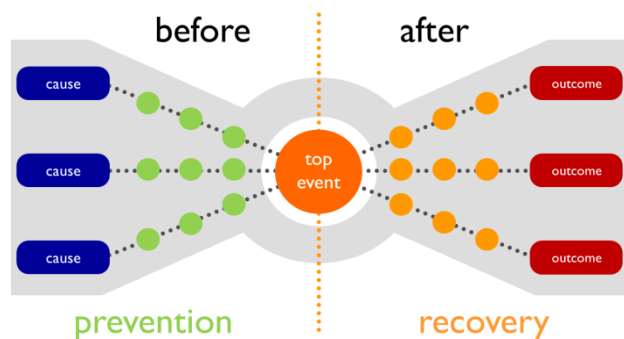
Attendees are required to have a basic understanding of risk management and basic computer skills of Microsoft office.
